Summer school of Belarusian as a foreign language is suitable for those:

The course consists of 60 academic hours (a two-week course), or 80 academic hours (a three-week course).

At the first lesson all the school participants will have a test to identify their level of language skill and according to the test results will be appointed into an appropriate level group.




