Why a European Games?



- Europe was only continent not to have its own multi sport Games pre 2015
- Number of Olympic medals won by Europe was continuously reducing:
- Seoul 1988 Europe won over 70% of Olympic medals
- Beijing 2008 Europe won less than 40% of Olympic medals
- Success of Baku 2015 clear from athletes perspective:
- 50 Gold, 50 Silver and more than 100 Bronze Rio 2016 Olympic medals were won by athletes who won medals in Baku 2015





VISITING BELARUS VISA-FREE FOR TICKETHOLDERS

10 June - 10 Jule 2019 года

A VISA-FREE TRAVELER **MUST HAVE:**

- Valid passport
- Medical insurance of 4 10.000 euro (can be purchased on site)
- Daily monetary allowance - at least 2 base amounts* for each day of stav



Citizens of 80 countries can stay in Belarus without visas for five days, including the arrival and departure



Mandatory requirement - arrival and departure via Minsk National Airport
