

## POSTAGE STAMPS OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS

The history of postage stamps of the Republic of Belarus begins on March 20, 1992 when the first Belarusian stamp "Cross of Saint Euphrosyne of Polotsk" was released into circulation. During these years over a thousand stamps have been issued (on 1.02.2015 - 1055 stamps).

Stamps reflect history, culture and art of a certain epoch. Thus postal issues represent and help to create the peculiar historical chronicles of the state by means of philately.

Belarusian stamps have a strong national trend. The most popular themes are:

- State symbols and heraldry;
- Flora and fauna of Belarus;
- Outstanding personalities;
- Art;
- Architecture of Belarus;
- Belarusian folk clothes;
- Sport.

Collecting postage stamps (**philately**) is the most massive and intellectual hobby in the world.

Postage stamps of Belarus reach the most remote corners of the planet easily overcoming national boundaries. Using their bright and expressive language postage stamps tell about Belarus to people in all countries of the world.




