The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia in Moscow presents its compliments to the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus, and with reference to the Indonesian immigration regulation, the Embassy wishes to advise the latter regarding the latest visa policy of the Government of the Republic of Indonesia.

Under the Minister of Law and Human Rights of the Republic of Indonesia's regulation No. 3 Year 2015 signed on 10 March 2015 and entered into force since 16 March 2015, citizens of Belarus can enjoy Visa on Arrival facility at the major airports in the Republic of Indonesia. Visa on Arrival is subject to its fee of USD 35. The length of stay is 30 days, extendable for up to 30 days with additional visa fee. Visa on Arrival is applicable for all types of passport (diplomatic, service and ordinary), but inapplicable for journalism purposes.

This visa policy is subject to further requirement of passport's validity which is not less than 6 (six) months from the date of arrival in Indonesia, with the sufficient pages for visa stamp.

The Embassy has further the honor to advise the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus in Moscow that the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Indonesia has sent a third note No. D/01361/04/2015/63 dated 24 April 2015 (as attached) regarding the visa policy above to all Diplomatic Missions and International Organizations in Jakarta, including the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus in Jakarta.

The Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the Republic of Belarus the assurances of its highest consideration.

Kebijakan visa juga mempersyaratkan masa berlaku paspor yaitu tidak kurang dari 6 (enam) bulan terhitung mulai tanggal kedatangan di Indonesia serta tersedianya halaman yang memadai untuk diterakannya visa pada paspor dimaksud.

Apabila di kemudian hari terdapat perubahan peraturan keimigrasian khususnya kebijakan visa, Kementerian akan segera menginformasikan lebih lanjut kepada seluruh Perwakilan Negara Asing dan Organisasi Internasional di Jakarta.
